## NJGPA Overview



- Statute requires the **State graduation proficiency** assessment to **administered to all grade 11 students**. (N.J.S.A. 18A:7C-6)
- NJGPA is designed to measure the extent to which students are graduation ready in English Language Arts (ELA) and Mathematics.
  - ELA aligned to the grade 10 standards
  - Mathematics aligned to Algebra I and Geometry standards

Mathematics	65.2%	55.0%	34.8%	45.0%



## ELA Spring 2023 NJGPA – Subgroup Performance








## Math Spring 2023 NJGPA – Subgroup Performance

#### **Achievements & Interventions**

- District out-performs the State in Math and ELA proficiency
  - However, still concerns in specific subgroup performance, especially in math
- Strategic Interventions
  - BSI/Portfolio Appeal course
  - RTI focus on attendance and school engagement
  - Mindprint Assessment
  - Benchmark Assessments
  - Building Thinking Classroom book study in math PLC
  - Freshman Supports and early identification through communication with sending districts
  - Increased articulation meetings with sending districts in English and Math
