Conclusions

- District Algebra I proficiency below NJ state %
 - Evaluating the standards/content in questions students answered incorrectly
- District Geometry, Science & English all exceeding NJ state %
- Increase in student participation in Science assessment
- Changes in the NJ assessment program & lasting impacts from pandemic
- Tests scores nationwide
 - NAEP largest drop in reading scores since 1990, first ever drop in math scores
 - SAT and ACT decrease in scores in 2022
- Trying to use other types of data to gather a more complete picture of student progress and achievement.

Responding to Student Need

- Working with sending districts to identify freshman students in need of early academic support
 - Expanded the Freshman Supports program
- Continue to monitor student performance on local assessments and make adjustments in the classroom
- Retaining best practices from remote instruction to monitor student engagement and attainment of knowledge & skills
- Focusing on social-emotional learning and student opportunities for engagement and belonging
- Offering expanded summer credit recovery for students with academic needs
